Recycling Bin Reminder

Recently the recycling bins have been used for dumping of household trash and larger items such as mattresses and appliances. These items are **not** allowed. The Police Department has been informed to issue illegal dumping citations which can be prosecuted as a third degree misdemeanor with a penalty of 60 days incarceration and a \$500 fine. For disposal of these items see the Community Clean-up Event below.
